Lived in the 3,000's BC during the Uruk Period after the Great Flood		
Built the earliest cities in Shinar / Sumer after the Flood		
Sumerian king credited with building Erech / Uruk		
Rebelled against God / Introduced pagan worship of false gods		
Built Massive buildings (Tower of Babel / Eridu Ziggurat + Enki Temple complex)		
Construction technique (baked mud brick with bitumen)		
Building site was abruptly abandoned		
Credited with / lived contemporaneous with invention of writing		
Renowned as being a hunter		
Name connection (N-M-R-D the hunter / N-M-R-kar)
